Nominated agencies will be evaluated on initiative, use of available resources, and overall results allowing agencies to share how they successfully curbed vehicle theft in their jurisdiction.

Law enforcement agencies, task forces, councils, community partnerships, and other theft prevention alliances worldwide are eligible for this award. Programs must have begun no earlier than the 2017 calendar year.


