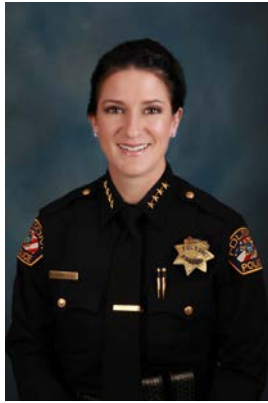




CYNTHIA E. RENAUD
