Cecelia Rosser is the Director of the Education Team at the International Association of Chiefs of Police. The education team develops and delivers law enforcement training and mentoring programs internationally, and conducts management studies, testing, assessments, and executive searches for police departments.

Prior to joining IACP in 2009, Ms. Rosser served for 28 years with various Federal agencies and in the Federal Senior Executive Service, retiring as a Deputy Inspector General. After serving six years with the Department of Defense, she spent 22 years as a federal law enforcement officer, manager and leader. While serving at the Departments of Defense, Treasury, and Transportation, the Social Security Administration, Postal Service and the General Accountability Office, she first led regional teams then national criminal investigation organizations. She served as an Assistant Inspector General for Investigations, the Deputy Inspector General for Investigations, Special Agent-in Charge and Assistant Special Agent-in-Charge where she managed criminal, civil, and administrative investigations.

She is a graduate of the University of Virginia, Federal Law Enforcement Training Center and various Department of Defense schools.
