VOLUNTEER JOB DESCRIPTION

POSITION: Speed Monitoring Awareness Radar Trailer (SMART) Deployer

RESPONSIBLE TO: Divisional Traffic Sergeant

LOCATION: Throughout the City at the discretion of the Division Traffic

Sergeant

GENERAL DESCRIPTION: Position deploys the SMART trailer to locations as designated by Division Traffic Sergeant based on citizen complaints regarding speeders.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Receive notifications of need of Smart Trailer from Traffic Sergeant or designee.
- Call citizen who requested Smart Trailer or made complaint and explain Smart Trailer process and date of deployment.
- 3. Deploy SMARt in accordance with Patrol Bureau SOP P1-156.
- 4. Talk with citizens who ask about the Smart Trailer.
- 5. At end of deployment, return Smart Trailer to storage area and turn in computer read out to Sergeant or designee.
- 6. Transport Smart Trailer to Events as requested or cleared by Sergeant.
- 7. Stay with the Smart Trailer to explain its use to the public.
- 8. Return Smart Trailer to storage.

TIME REQUIRED: Flexible schedule for deployments.

TRAINING: On-The-Job training with the Sergeant or the representative of the Sergeant.

QUALIFICATIONS: Good personal interaction skills. Own a vehicle able to tow the Smart Trailer. Ability to understand how the Smart Trailer works and its use. Ability to manually maneuver trailer as necessary. (Volunteer does have the right to refuse deployment of Smart Trailer if the volunteer believes s/he could be physically hurt or in danger.)

BENEFITS TO VOLUNTEER: Satisfaction of helping curb the speeding problem within the City. Interaction with the public on behalf of the Colorado Springs Police Department.
