IACP is recruiting law enforcement agencies for participation in a new initiative to identify promising practices and advance the field in law enforcement victim support. Victim-centered, trauma-informed approaches to crime can support victim recovery and engagement with the criminal justice system. These approaches promote enhanced victim and community safety while helping law enforcement solve and prevent crime.

Participating agencies will contribute to field advancement by helping assess practices, document successes, and identify challenges for victim-centered, trauma-informed approaches.

What are the benefits for our agency?

- Participating agencies will receive site-specific recommendations developed by subject matter experts.
- Three agencies demonstrating effective incorporation of practices across all ranks and disciplines will receive additional in-person site visits for enhanced data collection and targeted technical assistance.

What is the process to apply?

Step 1:	Review these FAQs – hold internal discussions to determine interest and commitment and identify an Agency Liaison.
Step 2:	Submit the completed Application by February 28, 2021
IACP, RTI, and the COPS Office will select case study sites and complete notifications by May 1, 2021
