

The State & Provincial Police Academy Directors Section (SPPADS) is dedicated to advancing the principles and competency of professional law enforcement instructors. The State and Provincial Police Planning Officers Section (SPPPOS) gives state and provincial police agencies a forum for information exchange, and access to the latest policies and best practices, with a focus on topics, needs, and challenges of interest to state police agencies.
