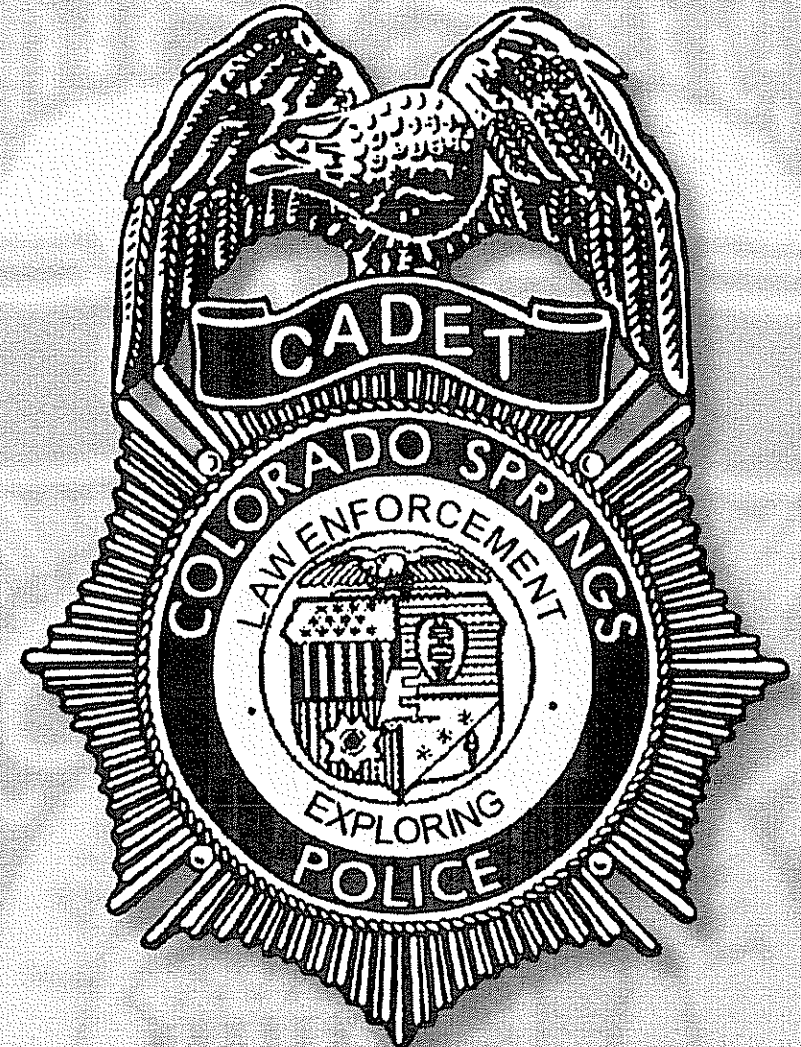

C.S.P.D. CADET PROGRAM

The Colorado Springs Police Cadet Explorer program is designed for young men and women between the ages of 14-1/2 and 20 years old.

This program allows young teens who live in or near the city of Colorado Springs to become informed and involved in law enforcement. While actively becoming a part of their community. This allows teens to further their knowledge and understanding of the criminal justice system through training, and to provide an insight into all phases of police work as a possible future profession and career. It will also help foster a better understanding between the Police Department and the youth of our City.

CADET PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- 1** MUST be between the ages of 14-1/2 and 20 to apply.
- 2** MUST have and must maintain a GPA of C (3.0) or better in school.
- 3** MUST pass a criminal history check, background investigation and an oral interview.
- 4** MUST be able to attend ALL 8 Training Sessions.
- 5** MUST maintain a 75%, or higher, cumulative GPA through the Cadet Basic Training Academy.
- 6** MUST join the Boy Scouts of America, Law Enforcement Explorer Post, prior to graduation. Cost is \$700 (Post Grants are available.)
- 7** MUST have parent's permission to participate in ALL Post functions, and if over 16 years of age, to ride-a-long with regular patrol officers.
- 8** MUST participate in most Community Service events, department requested special events and Post fund raisers. Fund raising is our only means of affording Cadet activities, such as social events, Post conventions, and to attend Explorer Competitions.
