

## DRE SECTION EMERITUS NOMINATION FORM



CRITERIA: The DRE Emeritus recognition is granted to a formerly certified DRE who has served the purposes of the DEC Program with the highest integrity, developed advanced knowledge and skill, and excelled in their field by making exceptional and extended contributions to the DEC Program and/or the DRE Section. Nominations must contain adequate documentation and explanation of such accomplishments. The nominee must no longer be eligible, either through retirement, promotion, or reassignment, to maintain active DRE certification. An individual cannot maintain certification as a DRE and hold the title of DRE Emeritus at the same time. DRE Emeritus status does not confer nor perpetuate DRE certification. Submissions lacking sufficient detail and/or justification will not be returned for additions to be reconsidered. The nominator may resubmit the following year with the additional information.




