The mission of the Des Plaines Police Department, in cooperation with our community, is to protect life, and enhance the quality of life for all our citizens.

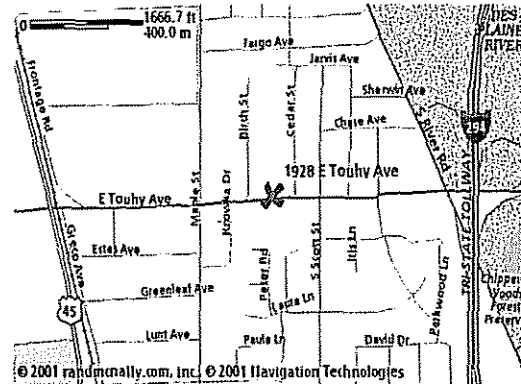
VIPS: Volunteers in Police Service
